RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF CONTRACT WITH

The MAYOR of the City of Santa Clara is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the County of Guadalupe for the collection of the City's current and delinquent ad valorem taxes, that contract to be in the form next hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein for all purposes.
