- **SECTION 1.** The City Council of the City of Santa Clara hereby appoints Floyd Akers SBN: 00790213 as interim City Attorney.
- **SECTION 2.** If any word, phrase, clause, sentence or paragraph of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the other provisions of this Ordinance will continue in full force and effect.
- **SECTION 5.** All ordinance and resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed.
